Introduction

With advancing online entertainment options, and innovations in digital TV and other home technologies, it's increasingly important to ensure our homes are wired to make the most of the new technologies and services becoming available.

A HPM Home Network utilises structured wiring. It's a modern wiring system that enables you to network computer and audiovisual entertainment throughout your home so these services are available in numerous locations, regardless of where the source equipment is located.

For example, with a HPM Home Network you can watch your favourite movie in multiple rooms, you can link all of your computers to print to one printer in your home office, and you can have more phone connections and more internet connections.


Most of all, HPM Home Networks give you more flexibility. The flexibility to access internet, telephone and audio visual entertainment in more locations. And the flexibility to change access points in the future with greater ease.

Telephone, fax, internet – Place phone and internet points in multiple locations – the kitchen, lounge, study and all of your bedrooms. Use phone lines with different phone numbers, ideal for homebased businesses.

Data – Network all of your computers and peripherals so they can share data, external memory and printers. Video – Watch free-to-air and Pay TV, as well as DVDs and videos in virtually any room you choose, regardless of where your main aerial connection or DVD player is located. And, by hooking up security cameras to the Video system you can keep an eye on the kids in the pool!

Audio – Enjoy listening to music or the radio whilst entertaining on the back deck, tinkering in the garage or relaxing in the bath.

IR Control – Relax in bed and flick between watching the game and a DVD using your existing remote controls, even though your DVD player is located in the lounge room.

Recommendation

With increasing broadband speeds, and the popularity of online entertainment, business, gaming and education, we strongly recommend including a minimum of 2 data ports and 2 TV points per room. This will help to 'future-proof' your home by catering for changes in your lifestyle.

Valuable Asset

Trying to retrofit home networking after a home has been built can be difficult and expensive.

HPM home network systems are considered an attractive asset and will add value to your home when you sell.



What does it look like?

Once installed, the only components a home network system that are visible are the central hub, which is usually placed in discreet locations such as the garage or internal cupboard, and the access points, which look like normal switchplates.

Telephone, fax and internet system

TELEPHONE, FAX AND INTERNET SYSTEM


With a Telephone, Fax and Internet system you can have up to 4 incoming phone, fax and internet lines distributed up to 12 locations utilising Cat 5e or Cat 6 cable.

This means you can have:

- your family telephone line distributed to the kitchen, lounge and bedrooms
- a business telephone line distributed to your home office
- a fax line distributed to your office
- an internet line distributed to the lounge room, bedrooms, or the office


If you wish to re-route any of your phone lines to different phone points in the future you can do this yourself without the need for an installer. When you have your system installed, your installer can show you how to do this: it is as simple as 'repatching' a lead from one port in your Home Network Central Hub box to another port.

Data system


DATA SYSTEM

With the Data system you can create a data network like a mini version of a network you may have in an office. All computers and peripherals such as printers and external memory devices are connected to a central hub which allows you to:

- share files between all your PCs and laptops
- access an external memory device from any of your PCs and laptops
- connect to your printer, wherever it is located in your home, from any of your PCs or laptops

If you want to work on your laptop in bed, but would like to connect to your home data network and access files on your PC in your home office, you simply plug-in the patch cord from the data point in your room to your laptop and work away in comfort!

Video system

VIDEO SYSTEM

With the Video system you can access Free-to-Air TV, Pay TV, DVD and live security camera footage in up to 8 locations, regardless of where your aerial connections, security cameras and DVD players are located.

To increase security and safety at home, you might like to consider installing security cameras in selected locations and hooking them up to the Video system. This will allow you to watch live security camera footage from any of your TVs. This is great for seeing who is at the front door when you are in bed, or keeping an eye on kids playing in the backyard when you are busy in the kitchen or home office.





Audio system


AUDIO SYSTEM

With the Audio system you can pipe audio entertainment from up to 4 different sources, such as stereos, MP3 players and radios, from 4 to up to 16 selected zones simultaneously to create a more pleasurable environment. This means you can:

- listen to the radio whilst getting ready for work in your ensuite
- plug-in your MP3 player and broadcast your 'Party' playlist out on the back deck when having a BBQ
- listen to the game when working in the garage
- listen to whatever you like whilst cooking in the kitchen, when the kids are playing their latest tracks in their bedrooms
- use the system like an intercom and communicate with people in other rooms of your home by pressing the Broadcast button and speaking into the Digital Volume Controller

Source equipment selection, volume, and treble and bass adjustments can be made in each zone via these Digital Volume Controllers.


IR System

IR SYSTEM

With the IR system you can use your existing remote controls to control source equipment such as Pay TV and DVD players when you are in a different room to where the source equipment is located. For example, you can be in bed switching Pay TV channels or controlling the DVD player via your remote control, even though your Pay TV box and DVD player are located in the lounge room.

How does this work? You point your remote control at an IR receiver and it will transmit the signals to your source equipment.





Home kits

For the best results, discuss your needs with your electrician and they will customise a HPM Home Network to suit your needs. To facilitate easier ordering we've created a couple of Home Kits, but you are not limited to these packages.

Standard Kit (HNMKSTD14)

This kit will allow you to have 4 incoming phone, fax or internet lines distributed to up to 12 locations. It will also allow y ou to access TV signals in 4 locations.



Similar to the Standard Kit, this kit will allow you to have 4 incoming phone, fax or internet lines distributed to up to 12 locations. The video system in this kit is much more powerful. Rather than just distributing TV signals to 4 locations, it will also combine signals from local sources, such as DVD players and security cameras and distribute these, as well as the TV signals, to up to 8 locations. This kit is highly recommended for larger family homes.




