



Mounting of NBN Co. Devices:

A "mounting surface template", as defined by NBN Co. in their specifications, is fixed to the top-right corner of the enclosure.

The mounting surface template is 565mm H x 325mm W and dedicated to the installation of NBN Co. devices only.

1. Unscrew mounting surface template from within the enclosure and mount the NBN Co. devices. (See above example figure a) Please refer to NBN Co. "Residential Preparation and Installation Guide: SDUs and MDUs" for more detailed information about layout and spacing between equipment (available on: www.nbnco.com.au).
2. Use Ø20 or 25mm cable entries (top/bottom/back of enclosures) to get incoming cables inside the NBNBOX/ NBNPPBOX.
3. Connect NBN Co. devices as per NBN Co. wiring instructions. A double GPO is provided to power NBN Co. Power Supply Unit (PSU) Enclosure must be earthed.
4. Screw mounting surface template back into the enclosure.

Flush Mounting Installation:

A dedicated bracket is required for installations where the enclosure needs to be recessed into the wall (partial recess only).

NBNBOXBracket: Kit to convert NBNBOX into a flush-mounting enclosure.

NBNPPBOXBracket: Kit to convert NBNPPBOX into a flush-mounting enclosure.

1. Cut out wall as per following dimensions:
NBNBOX: 710mm H x 390mm W
NBNPPBOX: 910mm H x 390mm W
2. Slide Bracket over box (from rear of box).
3. Position Bracket according to intended recessed depth (75mm or 90mm).
4. Screw Bracket to box using the M4 screws provided.
5. Insert box and bracket assembly into wall cut-out.
6. Screw from the inside of the box (side and top/bottom) towards wall studs.
7. Mount NBN Co. devices on mounting surface template (refer to Section 1. See opposite).
