

### Operation section

- The Legrand UPS Status Indicator (UPSSI) has been specifically designed to provide remote indication of the UPS Status in a medical environment and is suitable for installation in Operating theatres, Intensive care, Recovery wards, Isolation rooms, Nursing stations, Treatment rooms and other special care areas.
- The unit is connected to the UPS electrical supply system and will indicate 'Mains ON" with a Green LED indicator. The unit will indicate loss of supply to the UPS ("UPS in Emergency mode") with a synchronised, pulsating, audible alarm and a visual flashing Red LED alarm indicator, UPSSI is equipped with an audio mute button (the audible alarm will continue until mute). The visual alarm (and the audible alarm-if not muted) shall continue until the supply is restored to the UPS or the UPS is exhausted.
- The mute function can be configured to 'time out' if left unattended for periods of 1-4hrs.
- Upon total loss of the mains power, the alarm contacts will be in the "Closed Alarm" state.


### **Important Information**



## Mute Delay Setting Procedure

- Press and hold in the 'Mute' button on the unit and after approximately 15 seconds, the 'Red' LED on the unit will start to flash quickly and in time with the audible beep from the buzzer, the 'Green' LED will remain steadily 0N.
- Once the above flashing has started, let go of the 'Mute' button on the unit, wait for the Red LED to stop flashing and then press the 'Mute' button the desired number of times as per the list below. Each press will be accompanied by a flash from the 'Red' LED and a beep from the buzzer. Note: the maximum is five presses.
  - 1 Press = 1 Hour Delay
  - 2 Presses = 2 Hours Delay
  - 3 Presses = 3 Hours Delay
  - 4 Presses = 4 Hours Delay
  - 5 Presses = 1 Minute Delay
- After pressing the 'Mute' button the desired times, wait and the unit will confirm and indicate the number of times you pressed the button by flashing the 'Red' LED accompanied by an audible beep the number of times the button was pressed, this is to indicate to you the settings that it is storing
- The unit has now stored the desired settings and is ready for use.
